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Applications, changes due December 13

On January 1, employees who previously waived coverage can enroll in the group plan by completing an **Anthem Enrollment Application** (available from the primary contact at your group) and emailing or faxing it to ISMA Insurance Agency for processing.

Insured employees who previously waived coverage for dependents can add them by completing an **Anthem Enrollment Application** (available from the primary contact at your group) and emailing or faxing it to ISMA Insurance Agency for processing. **All requests for January 1 changes should be submitted by December 13 to allow time for processing.**

HSA 3200/6000 medical plan benefit changes

To comply with federal statutes, effective Jan. 1, 2025, the deductible for the current HSA 3200/6000 plan will be raised from \$3,200 per person to \$3,300 per person. The out-of-pocket maximum will also be raised from \$3,200 per person to \$3,300 per person. The maximum family deductible and maximum family out-of-pocket will remain at \$6,000. The plan name will be changed from HSA 3200/6000 to HSA 3300/6000 to reflect this change.

Anthem ID cards

Anthem will issue new Anthem ID cards in late December *only* to subscribers who change medical plans or add dependents.

How to maximize savings with an HSA

If you have one of the 3 HSA plans and a separate Health Savings Account, you can save money 3 ways.

- Contributions made via payroll deduction are tax-free; contributions made with aftertax dollars are tax deductible.
- 2. HSA funds are eligible for investment and enjoy tax-free growth potential.
- 3. When HSA funds are used for qualified, eligible medical, dental, vision, and other expenses, taxes don't apply. (You can even deposit funds into an HSA *after* incurring eligible expenses, then pay for them from your HSA and enjoy the tax benefit.)
